

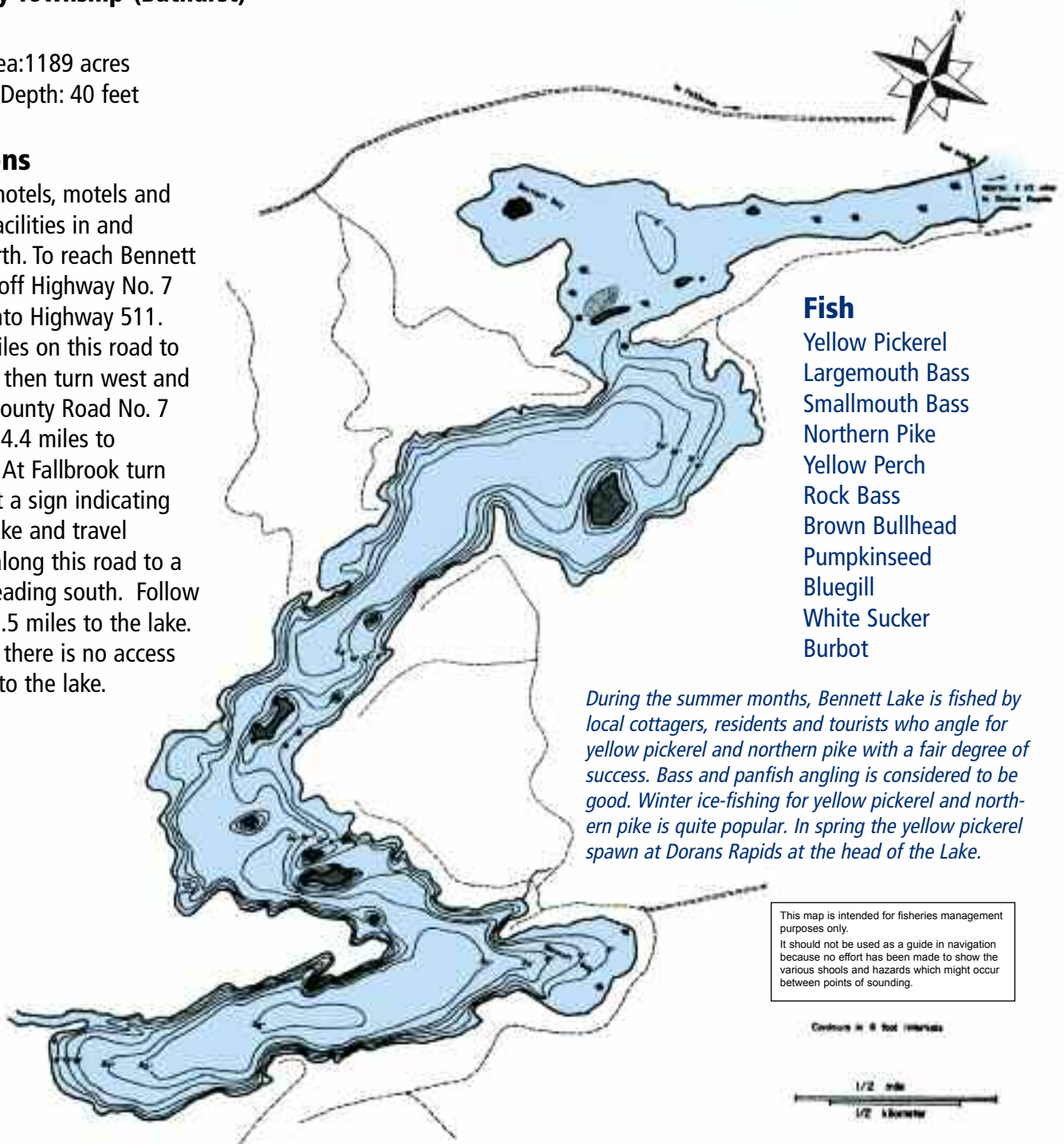
Bennett Lake

Lanark County
Tay Valley Township (Bathurst)

Surface Area: 1189 acres
Maximum Depth: 40 feet

Directions

There are hotels, motels and camping facilities in and around Perth. To reach Bennett Lake, turn off Highway No. 7 at Perth onto Highway 511. Travel 5 miles on this road to Balderson, then turn west and north on County Road No. 7 and travel 4.4 miles to Fallbrook. At Fallbrook turn westerly at a sign indicating Bennett Lake and travel 1.1 miles along this road to a sideroad leading south. Follow this road 2.5 miles to the lake. At present there is no access directly onto the lake.

During the summer months, Bennett Lake is fished by local cottagers, residents and tourists who angle for yellow pickerel and northern pike with a fair degree of success. Bass and panfish angling is considered to be good. Winter ice-fishing for yellow pickerel and northern pike is quite popular. In spring the yellow pickerel spawn at Dorans Rapids at the head of the Lake.
