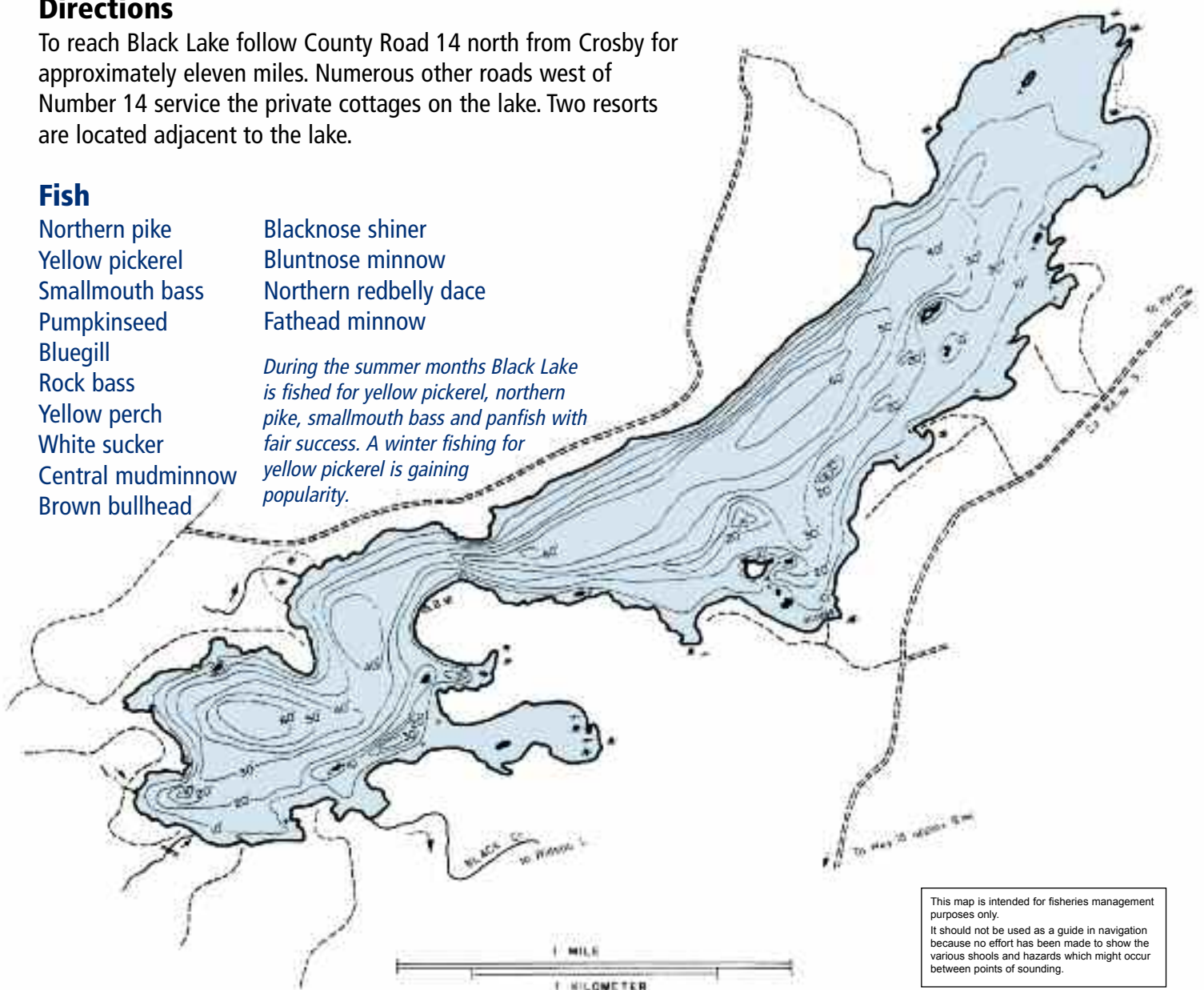
Directions

To reach Black Lake follow County Road 14 north from Crosby for approximately eleven miles. Numerous other roads west of Number 14 service the private cottages on the lake. Two resorts are located adjacent to the lake.
