Tay Valley Township (Bathurst and Tay River)

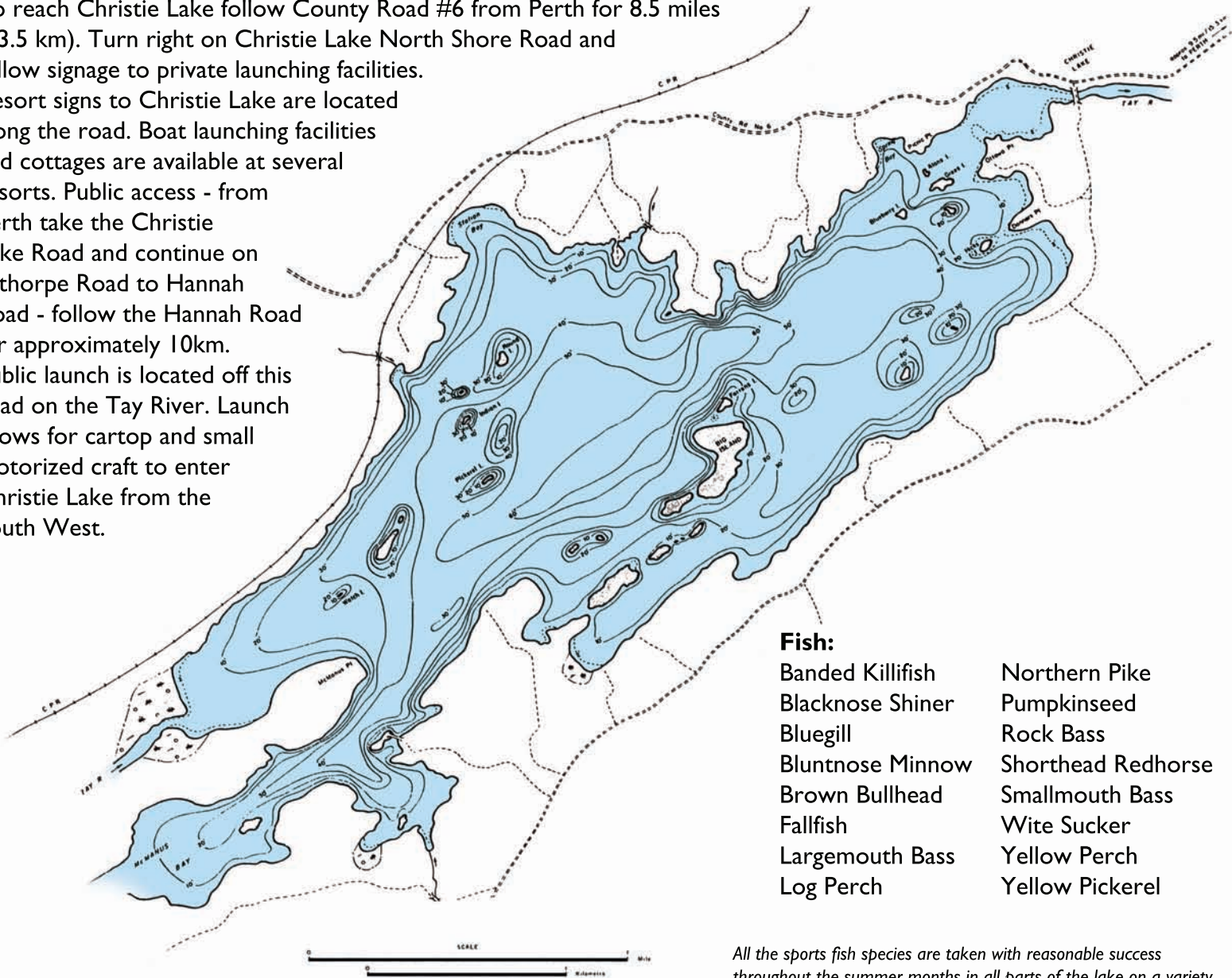
Surface Area: 1, 596 acres

Directions:

To reach Christie Lake follow County Road #6 from Perth for 8.5 miles (13.5 km). Turn right on Christie Lake North Shore Road and follow signage to private launching facilities.

Resort signs to Christie Lake are located along the road. Boat launching facilities and cottages are available at several resorts. Public access - from Perth take the Christie Lake Road and continue on Althorpe Road to Hannah Road - follow the Hannah Road for approximately 10km. Public launch is located off this road on the Tay River. Launch allows for cartop and small motorized craft to enter Christie Lake from the South West.

All the sports fish species are taken with reasonable success throughout the summer months in all parts of the lake on a variety of lures and live bait. Winter angling for yellow pickerel is becoming more popular.
