



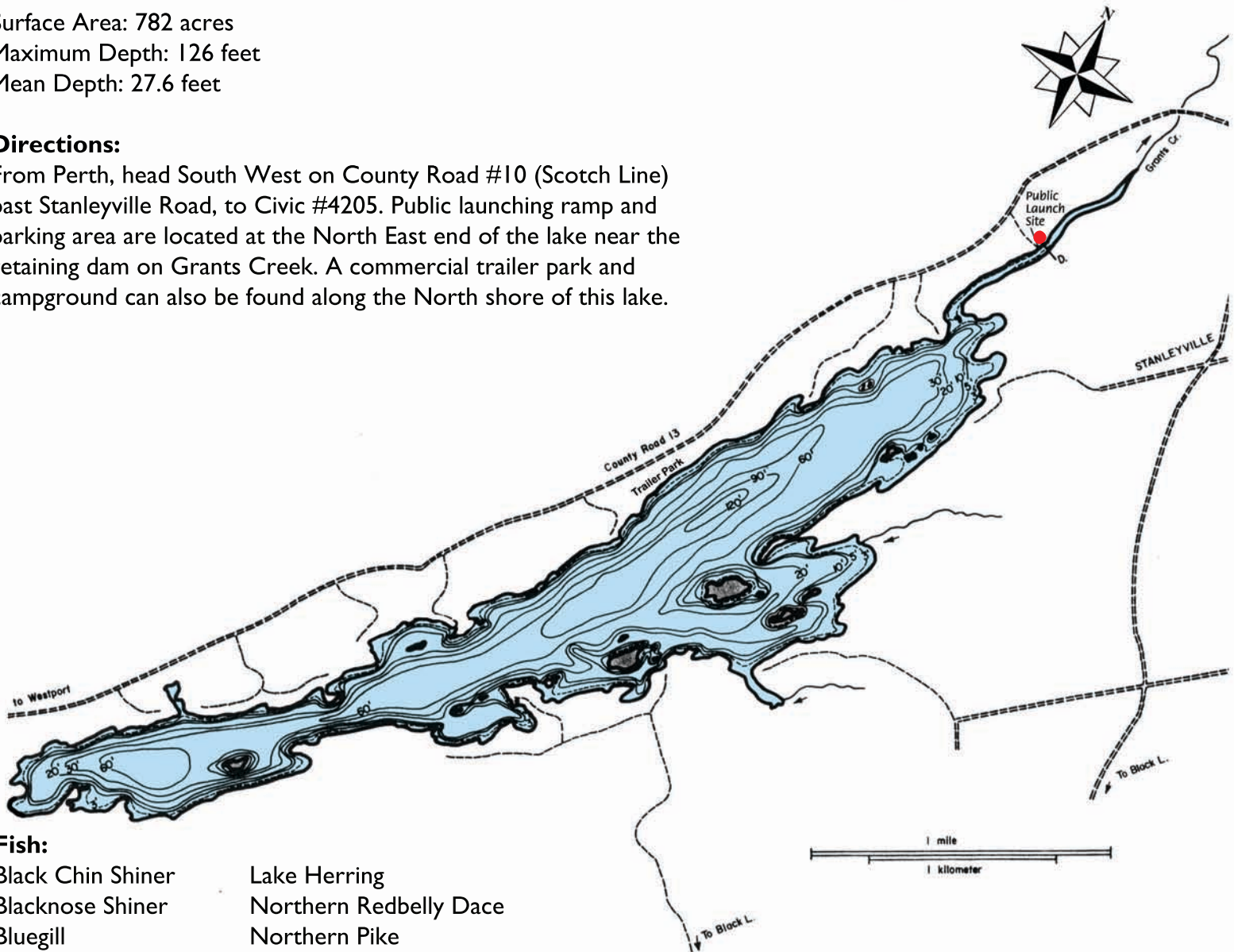
Pike Lake

Directions:

From Perth, head South West on County Road #10 (Scotch Line) past Stanleyville Road, to Civic #4205. Public launching ramp and parking area are located at the North East end of the lake near the retaining dam on Grants Creek. A commercial trailer park and campground can also be found along the North shore of this lake.
